- Not an official working group yet; currently discussing on Slack (#workflows).
- Considering rebranding workflows to better reflect modern understanding of the word (workflow -> Nextflow, snakemake etc)
 - Considering workflows, tutorials & recipes?
 - Suggestion from Aedin: ask also undergraduate students or early users which name would be most self-explaining.
 - Move from a linear "workflow" to a "playbook" with branching/decision points etc.
 - Leave the backend on the BBS unchanged with a focus on front-end changes (i.e. website)
 - Kozo: make workflows available interactively; for conferences https://workshop.bioconductor.org was/is used.
 - Kozo: Can the Orchestra platform [https://github.com/seandavi/Orchestra] be used for the workflow runner?
 - Lori: a basic tutorial or video on docker usage, base classes would be helpful.
- Plans to resolve the broken F1000R pipeline
 - Can we work with a checklist from the Journal of Open Source Education (JOSE) and push out to there with additional Bioc-specific criteria? Not an indexed journal though. Better options?
 - Would we need an editor representing Bioc on the JOSE board? Best way to administer?
